A Social Story





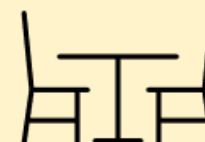
I will go to a community centre near me

a bus.



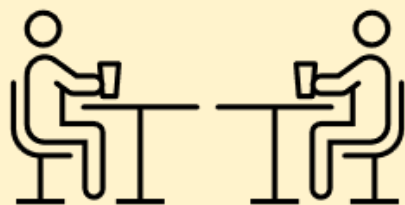
When I get there I will go to a room

CBD who will be happy to see me.



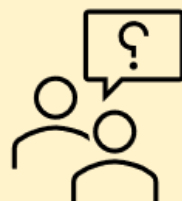
There will be other people also joining

another friendly person.



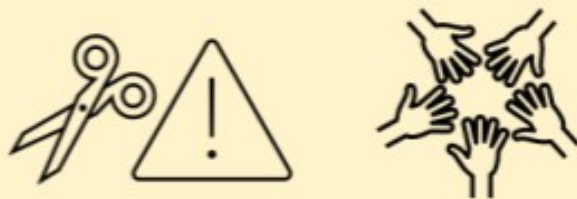
I am going to create bright and colourful

and I can follow along.



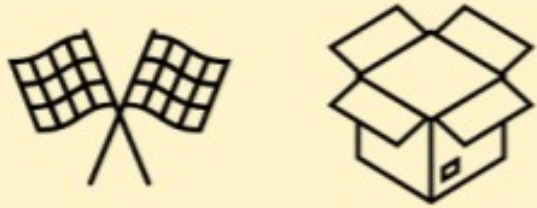
I can draw, stick, colour and design

me.



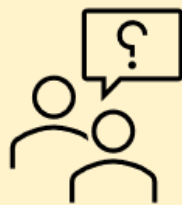
There is no wrong design.



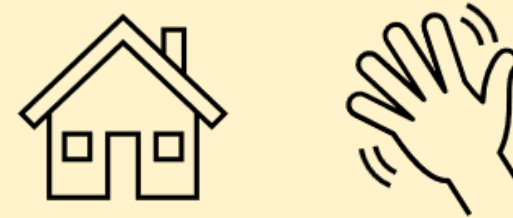
When the artists say it's time to finish I

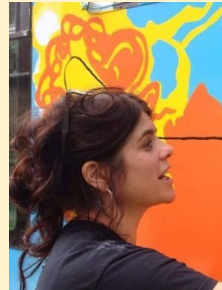
